Every 6 seconds a child dies of hunger. The organization, STOP HUNGER NOW, provides food for hungry children for 25¢ per meal. Meals are distributed to schools in third world countries for their school lunch program. Parents know that

their children receive a meal at school and so they more readily enroll their children in school – two ways to fight poverty: food and education!
